#### **Screening and Masks**

All visitors must be screened for respiratory symptoms and put on a medical mask prior to entry. Screeners are available Front entrance – 12:30-3:15pm Back entrance - 8:30am - 7:00pm

Medical masks must be worn in all common

areas/lounges/dining rooms. (\* can be removed in your resident room or outdoors Person Centre Care Initiatives DementiAbility- uses details about our resident's past and present and observations of their current behaviours to adapt the environment and our approach to improve their quality of life.

GPA:- Gentle Persuasive Approach is an education program that provides staff with the knowledge, skills and confidence to support persons with dementia and responsive behaviours, including escalated behaviours that may require gentle and respectful physical redirection.

#### **Research projects with UBC IDEA lab:**

Rosewood Manor is part of 2 research projects that use dementia friendly technology to lessen the negative behaviours associated with dementia.

1. Zinnia TV- dementia friendly programming used on TV, IPad and in an immersive reality setting. To provide an appropriate and engaging environment for residents with dementia.

2. *Silent Disco Headphones*- explore whether music delivered by silent disco headphones can support mental health and well-being among people with dementia. An information session was held on March 11<sup>th</sup>and the project will start in June. Stay tuned for more information.

#### **Goals of Care Conversations**

A palliative approach to care strives to support the best quality of life. For those residents not able to speak with us, we invite their substitute decision maker (SDM) to share input about the resident's wishes and preferences throughout their health journey. The care team will share their understanding, and concerns, about what lies ahead. Understanding what matters most to our residents allows the care team to provide care options that align with resident values. These conversations are called "Goals of Care". Goals of care conversations are part of the holistic care Rosewood provides each resident, and all interdisciplinary team members can support these conversations. Let's talk!

- 12. New Pressure relief Mattresses and toppers purchased. (available for wound management with OT assessment and recommendation)
- 13. Main Dining New Table tops anticipated April 2024
