### Person Centre Care Initiatives

**DementiAbility**- uses details about our resident's past and present and observations of their current behaviours to adapt the environment and our approach to improve their quality of life.

**GPA: Gentle Persuasive Approach** is an education program that provides staff with the knowledge, skills and confidence to support persons with dementia and responsive behaviours, including escalated behaviours that may require gentle and respectful physical redirection.

**Research projects with UBC IDEA lab:** Rosewood Manor is part of 2 research projects that use dementia friendly technology to lessen the negative behaviours associated with dementia.

1. **Zinnia TV**- dementia friendly programming used on TV, iPad and in an immersive reality setting. To provide an appropriate and engaging environment for residents with dementia.

2. **Silent Disco Headphones**- explore whether music delivered by silent disco headphones can support mental health and well-being among people with dementia. The project will start in June. Stay tuned for more information.

### Screening and Masks

On April 8, The Ministry of Health declared an end to the respiratory illness season and the additional infection prevention and control measures that were implemented last October. At the same time, the Ministry of Health launched the spring Covid-19 vaccine boosters. It was important to wait 10-14 days until the newly administered Covid-19 vaccines had reached their effectiveness level before removing masks, thus mask wearing was maintained until April 22.

### Building Updates

- New Staff room dining chairs have arrived - Staffroom reno is now complete. New sofas, chairs, new dimmable lighting and paint - all complete
- New Main Dining room table tops installed.
- Spring planting of new flowers and plants is complete - we can always use help to water in the drier months. Watering jugs are in the courtyards as well filling hoses.
- 5 new ceiling lifts installed.
- Wall protection and paint by the time clock area completed.
- New luxury vinyl plank flooring in the Roseroom.

### In the works :

- New water fountain/ bottle filler - filtered water dispenser - near the main staff room
- Tiered and raised planter garden bed at SCU courtyard
- Please note \*2nd floor bath Shower area will be shut down for approximately 10 days sometime in May to repair water damage. Walls will be updated to Stainless Steel.
- Telus is currently working on High-speed Fibre optic upgrade for resident room phones. Expected completion in early May. As always residents are responsible for the costs of their own cable and telephone and can choose from Rogers or Telus. Rooms are pre-wired for both options.
- New Cedar Pergola in the East courtyard. Repurposed gazebo is going to the South West Courtyard.
