InterRAI Resident Assessment

Rosewood Manor will be implementing interRAi LTCF on October 1, 2025. This is a comprehensive assessment conducted on each resident every 3 months and as needed to evaluate the needs, strengths and preference of our residents and help guide care planning. Nurses, leadership and allied health team members have completed training on how to complete the interRAI LTCF assessments.

Physical Building FY2024/2025 High Priority Capital Projects Update

- SCU Roof Replacement: Project commenced in July for a duration of 16 weeks. Additional ventilation needed to be installed with additional 1 week of work.
- Laundry boiler system replacement project has been awarded to PMH – installed and completed in June 2025.
- Air conditioning system installation in kitchen/dishwasher area complete. Invoices for BC Equip Climate Change grant was submitted and we will receive a cheque for \$46K
- Hallway/Room painting hallway painting completed, and currently resident rooms are being painted. 1st floor is complete and 2nd floor is now underway. Exposed sprinkler pipe lines and HVAC electrical conduits have been painted
- Submission made to BC Hydro for LED lights project. BC Hydro offering 50% rebate program until December 2025. We may also quality for a grant from BC Housing.
