Building Updates

Special Care Unit Re-roofing Project - The new roof is 95% complete. We are waiting for some materials to get the work completed. The target date of completion is by the end of November. Thank you for your patience.

North Spa Shower Room – The leak in the shower room has resurfaced and hence we have closed off the shower room until repairs are completed. The estimate time of completion is end of November. Staff have been utilizing the use of the shower room on the South side and on the Second floor. Thank you to our staff who have modified their work routine during this time.

LED Lighting Project – We are working with Luma Tech Solutions Canada to retrofit all our existing lighting fixtures to LED fixtures to reduce carbon emissions and reduce our energy cost by approx. 30%. This project will take place in November with completion date by the end of this year.

New Ceiling Lifts (5)

5 new ceiling lifts will be delivered and installed during the week of November 5-12, 2025. We will be installing these lifts in selected "B" and "C" rooms to accommodate changes in care and mobility needs of our residents.

Painting Project Completion

The 1st and 2nd floor main building painting project is complete. All resident rooms and common areas have been painted an offwhite color to bring our home brightness and a modern look.

Care Aide Day

On October 17, 2025 we celebrated our hardworking and compassionate care aides with a small gift and homemade soup and a bun.

Diwali

On October 21, 2025 we celebrated the Diwali, Hindu's festival of lights, with a staff potluck and a Rangoli sand activity with residents.

Anniversary Celebration

On October 24, 2025 we celebrated Rosewood's 43rd anniversary with a Bake Sale raising over \$300, and a Staff Talent Show where staff showcased their singing and dancing for colleagues, residents and visitors.

Flu and COVID Vaccine Update

Over the past few weeks, we have vaccinated over 95% of our residents against the Flu and COVID viruses. We had a small cluster of COVID cases; however, we managed to contain and resolve the cases within the month. We encourage everyone to regularly perform hand hygiene, and refrain from visiting if feeling unwell. Masks are available at the entrances for staff and visitors to use.

InterRAI

Rosewood Manor has completed the first month of InteRAI assessments on a third of the residents. interRAI is a comprehensive assessment conducted on each resident every 3 months to guide care planning and quality improvement projects through clinical indicators.

Quarterly Antipsychotic Review

In compliance with the Ministry of Health Mandate for the reduction of inappropriate antipsychotic use, Rosewood Manor continues to hold antipsychotic medication reviews with the physicians, pharmacist, nurses, and VCH Clinical Resource Nurse. Residents who are taking antipsychotic medications without an appropriate diagnosis will be reviewed and their Substitute Decision Maker will be contacted every 3 months to review and provide consent for the use of the medication.

Overtime Funding Cut

Effective November 1, 2025, The Ministry of Health will stop funding overtime costs for Long Term Care homes in BC. The leadership team in collaboration with the unions. We have developed algorithms to utilize during shift vacancies to ensure our residents receive safe care. We continue to hire nurses and care aides to build up our casual pools to reduce the need for overtime.
